<b>Description</b>			
<p><i>The event “Haus der Zukunft – Workshop zum Mitgestalten” took place on 23 October 2025 at Gösser Bräu in Graz and gathered citizens, stakeholders, and representatives from administration, science, and local initiatives to collectively explore future-oriented ideas for a resilient and sustainable city. After an introductory presentation outlining the vision of the “Haus der Zukunft”, participants engaged in four thematic discussion tables focusing on (1) the house as a social meeting place, (2) its role as a driver of innovation, (3) sustainable consumption and circular economy, and (4) its function as a central information hub on sustainability and climate action in Graz. The workshop continued with a collaborative foresight exercise (“Future Wheel”) where participants developed long-term impact scenarios for the year 2035, reflecting on potential societal, economic, and environmental consequences if the “Haus der Zukunft” had been successfully established and operating for five years. The event concluded with a summary of key insights, an outlook on next steps, and an invitation for further involvement.</i></p>
